Quality Policy Statement *01 June 2022*

- 1. In accordance with ISO.9001.2015 the Quality Management System (QMS), should be applied to all company projects and office locations, by staff and sub-contractors.
- 2. The QMS is in place to assist in our ambition to achieve "Zero Defects," with mitigation controls designed to achieve correct installation at the first attempt.
- 3. The controls to be applied by staff and sub-contractors are in accordance with the Quality Risk Assessments, produced to manage the processes undertaken at works locations.
- 4. An audit schedule will list the locations and ideal times, that "Inspections, Sampling and Audits" will be undertaken, and documented in accordance with company procedures.
- 5. Where practicable to do so, improvements will be measured on agreed action plans. These will form the basis of the criteria to measure and compare the performance of compliance.
- 6. The Employer's Requirements and Consultants specifications will form the main elements for planning quality control, quality assurance, and criteria for recording process on check sheets.
- 7. Necessary Quality Assurance Training will be undertaken which will include process awareness delivery of process requirements, as well as specific details of the elements within those specific processes.
- 8. Suitable and sufficient time will be spent planning the controls and evidencing the compliance through record keeping, which will be saved on the JFC filing system as a record of the installed works.
- 9. Materials should be assessed for correct use during the process. Data sheets supplied by manufacturers, will be provided to staff to ensure correct installation using best practices.
- 10. Where practicable to do so, improvement will be applied, and processes undertaken using best practice. So that standards are raised and the ethos of correct first time can be achieved.
